

Dominion Guild Nursing PhD Scholarships

Since its inception twenty years ago, Dominion Guild of Arlington, Virginia has raised funds for distribution to qualified projects and entities serving the Northern Virginia community. Every fall Dominion Guild raises funds by hosting a holiday house, featuring boutiques with gifts for sale from throughout the country. The proceeds from the holiday house are awarded to pre-selected charitable organizations, typically in January. Dominion Guild has given over \$364,000 to organizations in Northern Virginia.

The Dominion Guild has provided scholarships to undergraduate nursing students at George Mason University since 2003. Recognizing the shortage of nursing faculty, the membership voted in 2006 to also support PhD students at the College of Health and Human Services who intend to teach.

Criteria for the Dominion Guild Nursing PhD Scholarships:

- The recipient is a permanent resident of the United States.
- The recipient intends to work in Northern Virginia.
- The recipient demonstrates the ability to be recognized as a leader in nursing.
- The recipient must be in good academic standing.
- The recipient must clearly articulate career goals, including teaching and research in a one-page letter to the Director of the PhD Program in Nursing by ***October 26, 2007.***

Scholarships for 2008 Spring Semester:

A scholarship of \$2,500 will be awarded. To be considered for this scholarship, please submit a letter addressing the criteria listed above.
